Aug. 31, 1943.

Over here at night and mornings it is quite cold but in the afternoons it is quite ^{warm} ~~hot~~ so we go swimming. Also we have fun. We have a diving board and a raft. I just learned to do overstroke.

My mother is better now so do not worry. We have got another new baby boy his name is Luao John. Could you imagine two babies born in Slocan. Timothy is the first baby born. He is quite big now.

Stool will be starting pretty soon. We will be having a school at Popoff so we are lucky. Before we had to go way up to Bayfarm and it is about $1\frac{1}{2}$ miles.

At Bayfarm we had a Bon Dance. Gee it was pretty. They all

had kimono on. and I think there
was about 150 big and small girls.
They danced behind our Slocan
School. Gosh! it was pretty

Do you write to Nobuko Sasaki?
Well if you don't I've heard that
she has gone to Toronto. I wouldn't
mind going over there and visit it.
You know Rev. Nakayama he is
going to Toronto for a visit. Gee he's
lucky. He has been over to Sandon
Limon Creek, New Denver, Kaslo
I think.

bye so please take care of yourself
and your family.
